### PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

#### Curriculum Day Monday 12th August

#### Parent Opinion Survey

On Monday all parents received a Compass notification with information on the 2024 Parent Opinion Survey. Our school is conducting the annual Parent Opinion Survey offered by the Department of Education and is seeking your feedback. The survey is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of families' perceptions of school climate, student behaviour, and student engagement. The survey is optional, but we encourage and appreciate your participation.

Our school will use the survey results to assist in identifying areas for improvement and professional development needs in the school, to target school planning and improvement strategies. The Parent Opinion Survey will be open online from Monday 29 July to Friday 30 August 2024. Please refer to the Compass notification for the school username and PIN.

#### Parking in the Disabled Parking in the Phoenix Park Library Car Park

We have noticed that some members of our community are parking in the allocated disabled car parks, that do NOT have a permit to do so. We have families within our community that must be able to access the disabled parking facilities to be able to get their child to school safely. Even if you are thinking "I will only be in for 5 minutes", I strongly urge you to rethink and find another park that you are entitled to use.

We are beginning to develop our WorkForce Plan for 2025. If you are leaving MVPS at the end of the year can you please let the office know so that we can assist your child with transition processes and to plan our classes for 2025.



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### Inclusion Outreach Coach

The Inclusion Outreach Coaching (IOC) initiative is being delivered by the Department of Education as part of the Disability Inclusion reform agenda. The IOC initiative supports schools to implement inclusive education practices with advice and expertise from Inclusion Outreach Coaches. Inclusion Outreach Coaches (IOCs) are based in specialist schools and provide strategically coordinated capability-building opportunities to partner schools. Their focus is on building the capability of school workforces, including school leaders, middle leaders, teachers and other staff.

IOCs have expertise in inclusive practices and problem-solving, a deep knowledge of teaching and learning, and the skills to coach and support others. They establish Partnership Agreements with partner schools, which identify a clear goal for improvement in inclusion, tailored to the school's specific needs and context. IOCs support partner schools through a time-limited engagement to embed inclusive practices and improve student outcomes in learning and wellbeing. IOCs build school capacity by using a systems lens approach and data to inform decision making and strategic planning.

Our IOC is Jenny and she has been working with a P-2 team of teachers and our Inclusion Team. Our SMART goal and Action Plan is: *By the end of Term 3, 2024, Prep-2 classes at Malvern Valley Primary School will introduce 'Transition Regulation' activities for 10-20 minutes after key transition times, to support student sensory needs and develop self-regulation and readiness for learning strategies, by increasing student engagement and student voice to reduce dysregulated behaviour.*

We look forward to seeing the positive impact this work has for our students over the coming weeks.

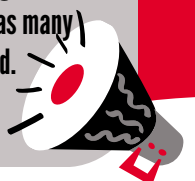
## SAVE THE DATE

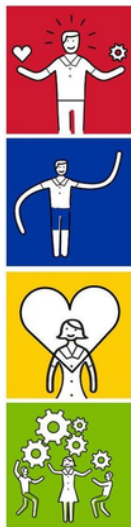

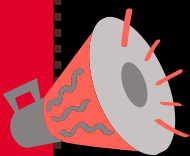

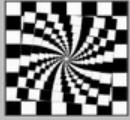
